# FAQ'S CAMP HANES STAFF

## **How many weeks do Junior Counselors work?**

Junior Counselor's must attend the week of training at the beginning of the summer and then are asked to work three weeks. We typically break it up to work either sessions 1-3 or session 4-6. Training week for 2019 is June 9<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>.

## **What type of training do I receive?**

All staff receives a minimum of a week-long training in addition to some online training to become First Aid/CPR certified and an online orientation training for the Y. There is also potential based on position and experience to become Lifeguard cert., Belay/High Ropes Cert. , and Shooting Sports Cert. If the position includes supervising other staff then you will attend a Leadership Training as well.

## **Is there a staff uniform?**

Yes, we provide polos for Sundays and a daily staff shirt for every other day of the week as well. We do ask that staff wear and provide for themselves khaki type shorts/pants on Sunday to be worn along with the polo. We also provide a hat to wear and replace any other head wear you would typically wear. Thursdays are theme wear day where staff can choose to dress up for the theme instead of wearing their staff uniform.

## **Does Day Camp staff live onsite?**

Day camp staff is provided a place to stay if they choose to live onsite; some staff live locally and choose to live at home as well.

## **What does time off look like?**

Due to the nature of summer camp we prefer staff be ready to work most of the summer sessions. We ask that staff present time off request as soon as possible and at minimum two weeks ahead of time prior to requested day/week off.
